Housing Policies and Fees

Housing is available on a year round basis for individuals and small groups engaged in educational or research activities at Lilley Cornett Woods. The facilities include a Research Learning Center with a wet lab classroom that has seating for 24 and a dry lab classroom with facilities for 12, plus a bunkhouse with sleeping accommodations for 10. In addition, there is the historic Ledford-Craig house located adjacent to Lilley Cornett Woods. Currently, the house includes sleeping accommodations for 10, 1 common bathroom, a fully equipped kitchen, a common living area, and a magnificent view of a beautiful Appalachian valley. Also, camping in designated areas is possible with permission. Note: The Ledford-Craig house is not ADA accessible, at this time.

Use Policies

1. Initial reservations should be made at least 10-15 days in advance of your stay by contacting Karen Pratt at EKU's Division of Natural Areas, karen.pratt@eku.edu or 859-622-1476.
2. Once tentative reservation date is establish, group will contact ECU Conferencing and Events, attention – Polly Rose: polly.rose@eku.edu or 859-622-1444, to obtain reservation contract.
3. Check in and check out times are between 8:00 am - 4:30 pm Monday through Friday, unless special arrangements are made with the onsite Manager.
4. Sharing the house with multiple non-related parties may occur with the consent of the different groups.
5. ECU does not permit smoking or alcohol use in any of its residences.

Visitor Responsibilities

1. Provide all your own bedding, including pillows.
2. Provide all your own food. The kitchen is stocked with plates, silverware, pots & pans, basic kitchen linens, cleaning supplies, refrigerator space, cabinets and shelves.
3. Visitors are required to keep the house and/or bunkhouse clean and leave it in the condition found at the time of assignment. Cleaning supplies will be available for use. All dishes must be washed and food removed from the refrigerator at check-out time.
4. Trash should be kept inside the house in the designated containers. It will be collected by LCW staff on a regular basis. Please do not place outside due to the potential for wildlife attraction.
5. Visitors are held responsible for any damage they cause and will be charged the full cost of any required repairs.
